Any products for pets are not applicable. <p>Separate garbage in transparent or semitransparent bag following the garbage disposal instructions, and put them in the appropriate containers placed at the garbage collection points.</p> <p>Collection site: East side parking area of Tsubame city office (1934 Yoshida Nishiota)</p> <p>Collection time: From 9:00am to 5:00pm (everyday including Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays)</p> <p>No collection from December 29th, 2023 to January 3rd, 2024.</p> <p>There may be times when garbage collection services are temporarily suspended.</p>
