Categories	Bag Types etc.	Garbage Categories and Disposal Methods
<b>Burnable</b>	可燃ごみ用	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Kitchen waste, paper waste, plastic containers, CD, Sneakers and Rubber boots, Clothes, Garden Waste, Styrofoam, Small plastic products</li> <li>Completely drain water from all food products</li> <li>Cut items into pieces under 40cm x 5cm (L x W)</li> </ul>
<b>Non-Burnable</b>	不燃ごみ用	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Glass, Ceramics, Umbrellas, Incandescent light bulb, LED Bulb, Leather Shoes and Goods, Large Plastic Products</li> <li>Wrap dangerous items (like glass) in newspaper and write ケケン on the bag</li> </ul>
<b>Cans</b>	Please place in the specified container	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Beverage Cans, Cans and Confectionary Cans, Cooking Oil Cans, Spray Cans</li> <li>Wash food cans</li> <li>Ensure that aerosol spray cans are completely empty (including gas), and puncture the can in a well-ventilated area</li> </ul>
<b>Metals</b>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Crocks, Kettles, and Frying Pans, Metal Tableware and Nail, 18L Cans</li> <li>Remove fuel or batteries from stoves, heaters and portable gas stoves</li> <li>Put needles and razors in a metal container</li> </ul>
<b>Bottles</b>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Food, Beverage, and Cosmetic Bottles</li> <li>Returnable/Recyclable Bottles: Beer, 1.8L, Milk, Juice</li> <li>Wash bottles</li> </ul>
<b>Batteries</b>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Batteries and Button batteries</li> <li>Please take rechargeable batteries with the mark on the left to a designated recycling store.</li> </ul>
<b>PET Bottles</b>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Remove cap, Remove label, Empty and rinse the bottle, Squash and put in a PET Bottle collection net</li> <li>Only PET Bottles with this mark can be recycled</li> </ul>
<b>Paper</b>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cardboard (which has corrugated sections), Newspaper, Magazines and Flyers, Paper Boxes, Cartons (Silver lined cartons are burnable)</li> <li>Shiny, printed paper is considered as 'Paper Boxes'</li> <li>Plastic coating is considered as 'Burnable'</li> <li>Remove films and plastic wrapping</li> <li>Each type should be gathered and tied separately</li> </ul>
<b>Oversized Garbage (Upon Request)</b>	Purchase stickers from agents according to the size of the garbage	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Duvets, Blankets, and Cushions, Large Appliances and Furniture</li> <li>Do not leave these items in garbage areas</li> <li>These items can only be picked up at the entrance of residence</li> <li>Please call this number TEL 0256-97-5885 by noon of the working day prior to the collection date</li> </ul>
<b>Old Clothes</b>	Transparent or Semi-Transparent Bag	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The old clothes, such as a suit, and a shirt, bed sheets, a towel, a variety of cloth, a belt, a bag, a pair of shoes, and a variety of leather products. ※Any products for pets are not applicable.</li> <li>Separate garbage in transparent or semitransparent bag following the garbage disposal instructions, and put them in the appropriate containers placed at the garbage collection points.</li> <li>Collection site: East side parking area of Tsubame city office (1934 Yoshida Nishiotai)</li> <li>Collection time: From 9:00am to 5:00pm (everyday including Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays)</li> <li>We are unable to accept reservations during the New Year holidays.</li> </ul>
