<b>Non-Burnable</b>	不燃ごみ用	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Glass</li> <li>● Ceramics</li> <li>● Umbrellas</li> <li>● Incandescent light bulb, LED Bulb</li> <li>● Leather Shoes and Goods</li> <li>● Large Plastic Products</li> </ul> <p>● Wrap dangerous items (like glass) in newspaper and write ケケン on the bag</p>
<b>Cans</b>	Transparent or Semi-Transparent Bag	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Beverage Cans</li> <li>● Cans and Confectionary Cans</li> <li>● Cooking Oil Cans</li> <li>● Spray Cans</li> </ul> <p>● Wash all food cans</p> <p>● Ensure that aerosol spray cans are completely empty (including gas), and puncture the can in a well-ventilated area</p>
<b>Metals</b>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Crocks, Kettles, and Frying Pans</li> <li>● Metal Tableware and Nail</li> <li>● 18L Cans</li> </ul> <p>● Remove fuel or batteries from stoves, heaters and portable gas stoves</p> <p>● Put needles and razors in a metal container</p>
<b>Bottles</b>		<p>● Food, Beverage, and Cosmetic Bottles</p> <p><b>Returnable/Recyclable Bottles</b></p> <p>Requesting an appropriate electrical appliance store a collection of the unnecessary electronic products.</p> <p>● Beer 1.8L</p> <p>● Milk</p> <p>● Juice</p> <p>● Wash bottles</p>
<b>Newspaper/ Cardboard</b>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Newspaper (no flyers)</li> <li>● Cardboard (which has corrugated sections)</li> </ul> <p>● Shiny, printed paper is considered as 'Paper Boxes'</p> <p>● Plastic coating is considered as 'Burnable'</p>
<b>Magazines/ Paper Boxes</b>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Magazines and Flyers</li> <li>● Paper Boxes</li> </ul> <p>● Remove films and plastic wrapping</p>

<b>Old Clothes</b>	Transparent or Semi-Transparent Bag	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● The old clothes, such as a suit, and a shirt, bed sheets, a towel, a variety of cloth, a belt, a bag, a pair of shoes, and a variety of leather products.</li> <li>● Separate garbage in transparent or semitransparent bag following the garbage disposal instructions, and put them in the appropriate containers placed at the garbage collection points.</li> </ul> <p>※Any products for pets are not applicable.</p>
